As an example, check out the distribution of the Admission Brown University; Below is a screen capture: If you look at the highest scoring (36), 23.8% of the candidates who marked a 36 were accepted for Brown, which Significantly higher than the general brown admission rate 8.7%. You can see that, as your score begins to decline (You receive between 33 and 35) Your admission chance falls 11.1%, 23.8% to 12.7%. The lesson to take from this data is the biggest score, the best of your chance to be accepted. In my graphic above, the two "target" punctions vary by 1 point, so that you should point out? Aim for the highest target score on your list. That way, when you reach the highest target score, you have the best chance of admissions at all universities on your list. If you have 34 and applied to UC Berkeley and Michigan University, you would have a great chance of being accepted for both. However, if you aimed at the lowest scoring and received a 33 and applied to the University of Michigan, you will now be aqitious of the 75th percentage score and would be in the middle of 50% of the scores admitted. You still have a decent chance of being accepted, but your chances are not so good. Step # 4: Create a plan to reach your score of destination act.
